Overnight Ramp Closures at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road Planned Next Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Overnight detours at the J. Turner Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) and San Pablo Road interchange are planned for Monday, July 18 through Wednesday, July 20, and could extend into subsequent nights pending weather and unforeseen circumstances. The closures are necessary to allow crews to complete paving and installation of pavement markings through the interchange.

From 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night, intermittent road and ramp closures will be in place around the interchange. Drivers should follow posted detour signage, slow down and use caution when traveling through the construction zone.

FDOT selected Watson Civil Construction, Inc. to complete this \$12 million project in summer 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
