Overnight Ramp Detours Planned October 4 and 5 at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road Interchange

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's interchange improvement project at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road, overnight detours are planned Sunday, October 4 and Monday, October 5.

The ramp from San Pablo Road to westbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. Sunday, October 4 until 6 a.m. Monday, October 5. Drivers will be detoured to eastbound Butler Boulevard, where they will continue to the South Beach Parkway exit and turn left onto South Beach Parkway to access the ramp onto westbound Butler Boulevard (shown below).



The ramp from San Pablo Road to eastbound Butler Boulevard will be closed from 8 p.m. Monday, October 5 until 6 a.m. Tuesday, October 6. Drivers will be detoured to westbound Butler Boulevard to the Hodges Boulevard exit, where they will be able to access eastbound Butler Boulevard (shown below).



FDOT hired Watson Civil Construction to complete this \$12 million project, which includes construction of a diverging diamond interchange at San Pablo Road and Butler Boulevard, in spring of 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
