Painting and Repair Work on Ribault River Bridge Set to Begin

Jacksonville – Construction is expected to begin February 25 on a bridge rehabilitation project on Lem Turner Road (State Road 115) at the Ribault River.

Project improvements include bridge painting, fender repairs and other incidental construction to the northbound Ribault River Bridge.

Contractor Seminole Equipment, Inc. is expected to complete the \$731,000 project in spring 2020, weather and schedule permitting.

Most project work will take place during daytime hours, Sunday through Friday. No lane closures will be permitted from 3:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. When lane closures are needed, drivers will be alerted in advance via portable, changeable message signs. Lane closure notices are available online at www.nflroads.com.

The Florida Department of Transportation urges motorists to always follow the speed limit and stay within the limits of orange cones and barrels while traveling through construction zones. Call (904) 831-FDOT with any questions about this or other projects within FDOT District Two.
