Ramp from San Pablo Road to Eastbound Butler Boulevard to Close Overnight Sunday and Monday

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's interchange improvement project at Butler Boulevard and San Pablo Road, the ramp from San Pablo Road to eastbound Butler Boulevard will be closed nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, November 1 and Monday, November 2.

Drivers will be detoured to westbound Butler Boulevard to the Hodges Boulevard exit, where they will be able to access eastbound Butler Boulevard (shown below).
