Repair work to begin on I-95 overpass at Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway

Jacksonville – The Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway (U.S. 1) overpass at I-95 will see repair work for the next 50 days as construction crews work to replace, reform and repair portions of the overpass.

During construction, drivers can expect periodic single lane closures on northbound I-95 between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. At times, two lanes may be closed on northbound I-95, however multi-lane closures may only occur between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

The outside, auxiliary lane on northbound I-95 between Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway exits 354A and 354B will be closed throughout the duration of the project. Both exits will remain open.

Westbound Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway will see periodic detours between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. throughout the duration of the project. During necessary detours, message boards and signs will guide drivers through the detour. Once available, a map of the detour will be posted on FDOT Northeast Florida social media channels.

Construction work on this project will be restricted during Memorial Day and Independence Day.

The project is expected to be completed in 50 days.
