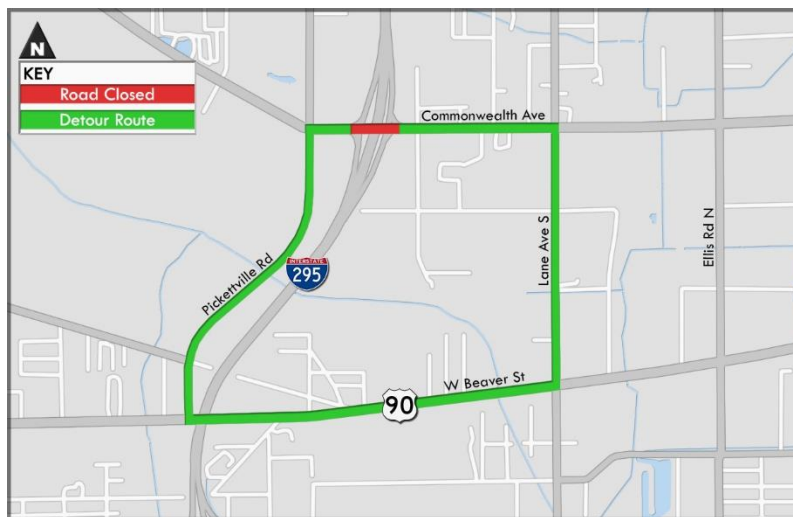

Repairs to the I-295 Bridge Over Commonwealth Avenue Continue *Commonwealth Avenue to see overnight detours this weekend*

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Repairs to the I-295 south bridge over Commonwealth Avenue began Monday, July 18 and are expected to continue until late August 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

As part of these repairs, Commonwealth Avenue will be detoured at I-295 Sunday, July 31 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. During this detour, drivers on Commonwealth Avenue will be unable to travel under the I-295 bridge. Depending on the direction of travel, drivers may be directed to Pickettville Road or Lane Avenue to connect with Beaver Street and reach their destination. (See map below.)
