
Royal Way to Close Temporarily at State Road 20 for Reconstruction Work

HAWTHORNE, Fla. – As part of the widening improvements on State Road 20 from the Putnam County line to SW 56th Avenue, Royal Way will be temporarily closed to traffic at State Road 20 Tuesday, March 2 through early May, weather and schedule permitting. The closure is necessary to safely complete roadway reconstruction work.

Drivers will detour via Lake Galilee Drive and Main Street (map below).

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$49 million improvements by late 2022, weather and schedule permitting.
