San Juan Avenue Near U.S. 17 to Close July 24 for Railroad Crossing Construction

Detours are expected to remain in place through August 6 as crews rebuild the crossing.

Jacksonville – San Juan Avenue (State Road 128) will close in the immediate area of the railroad crossing located near U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) as part of a project to replace the crossing surface. Construction is expected to begin Wednesday, July 24 at 5 a.m. and is scheduled to be completed by Tuesday, August 6 at 6 p.m. The roadway will reopen early if work is completed ahead of schedule or could be closed longer if there are weather or other unforeseen delays.

During the closure, traffic will be detoured via Blanding Boulevard (State Road 21), Timuquana Road (State Road 134) and U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) as seen in the map below.
