Soutel Drive to Close February 11-14 for Railroad Crossing Work

Jacksonville – Soutel Drive will close in the immediate area of the railroad crossing located south of New Kings Road (U.S. 1). The railroad crossing will close Sunday, February 11 at 7 a.m. and is scheduled to reopen Wednesday, February 14. The roadway will reopen early if work is completed ahead of schedule or could be closed longer if there are weather or other unforeseen delays.

A detour will be in place during the closure. Drivers traveling north on Soutel Drive will detour to I-295 and New Kings Road and drivers traveling south will detour to New Kings Road and I-295 (map below).


CSX will be performing maintenance work on the crossing, including installation of new rail.
