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## Southbound State Road 9B detour planned this weekend for construction

**Jacksonville** – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's extension project of State Road 9B (S.R. 9B) from I-95 to County Road 2209, a detour will be in place on southbound S.R. 9B at I-295 starting Saturday, July 21 at 10 p.m. through Monday, July 23 at 5 a.m. to install overhead roadway signs, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Motorists intending to travel southbound S.R. 9B at the I-295 exit ramp will exit at U.S. 1 and travel south to enter southbound S.R. 9B. As an alternative, motorists traveling southbound S.R. 9B may also utilize I-95 to detour.

The new four-lane divided highway, will connect I-95 in Duval County to St. Johns Parkway/County Road 2209 in St. Johns County. The project includes overpasses at Race Track Road, Durbin Creek and Russell Sampson Road and a connector road, Peyton Parkway, from Race Track Road to S.R. 9B. The connector road will provide direct access to S.R. 9B.

Construction of the 2.3-mile extension (final phase) of S.R. 9B into St. Johns County began in August 2015 and is scheduled for completion this summer, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
