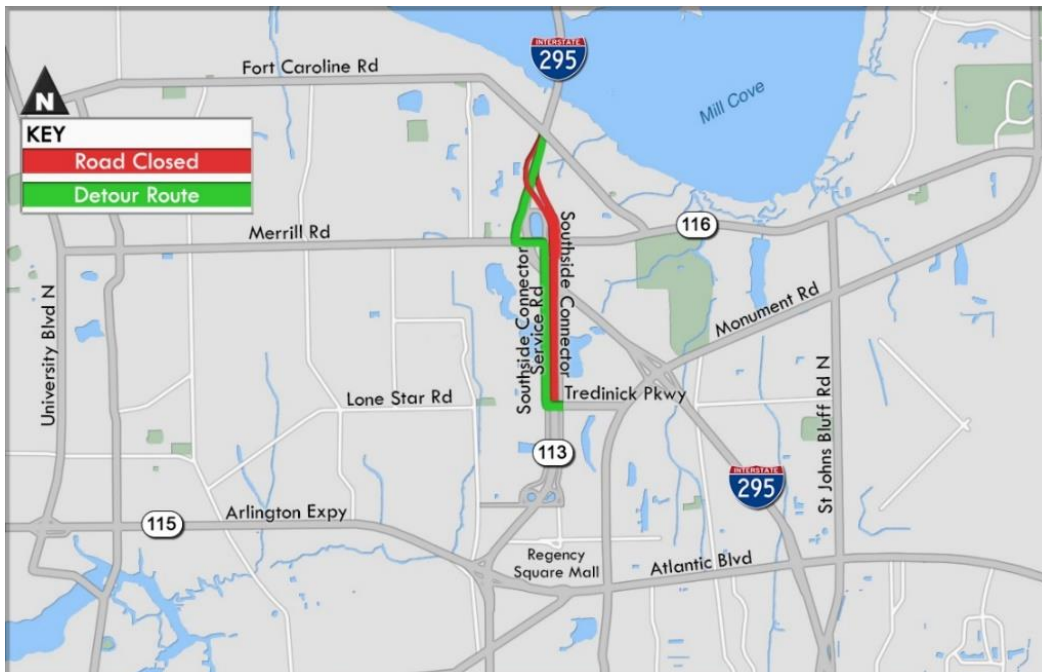

Southside Connector Southbound from I-295 to Atlantic Boulevard Closed Overnight through September 1

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Southside Connector (State Road 113) southbound lanes from I-295 to Atlantic Boulevard and the Regency Square Boulevard North ramp are scheduled to close overnight starting tonight, Monday, August 30 through Wednesday, September 1. The closures are needed to allow for the installation of overhead highway signage associated with the Southside Connector resurfacing and improvement project.

Monday, August 30: Southbound lanes of the Southside Connector from I-295 to Tredinick Parkway will close at 7 p.m. and reopen by 7 a.m. Tuesday. Traffic will detour to I-295, Merrill Road and the Southside Connector Service Road. (Detour and closure shown in Map 1 below.)

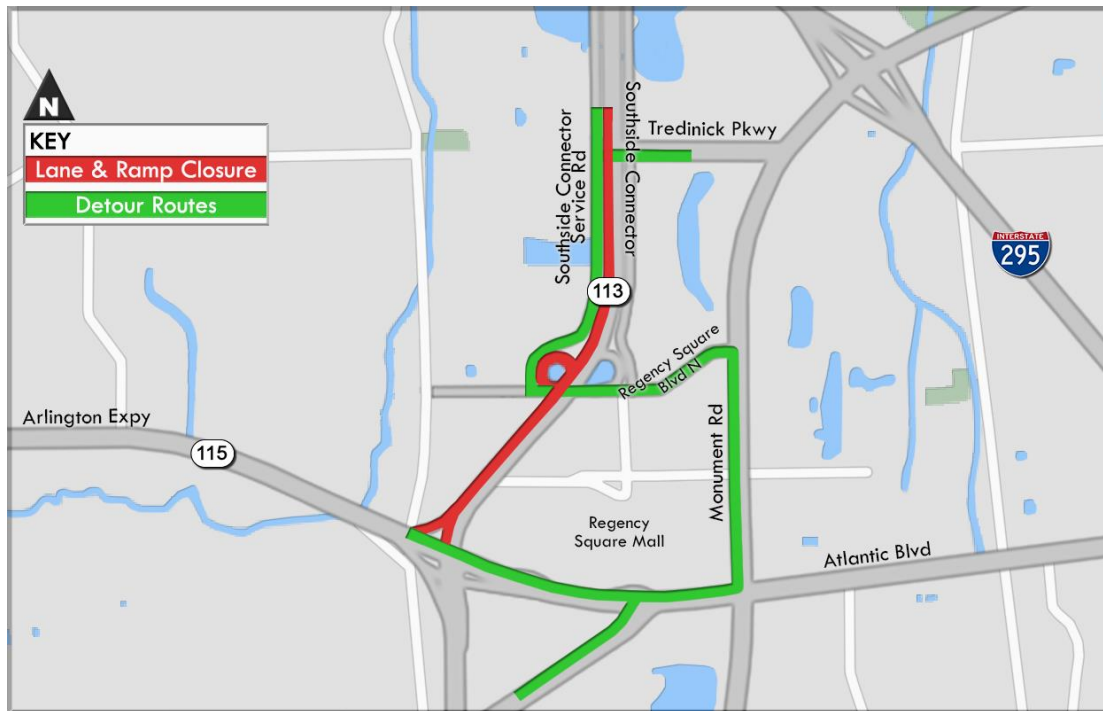

Tuesday, August 31 and Wednesday, September 1: The Southside Connector southbound lanes from north of Tredinick Parkway to the Arlington Expressway and the ramp from eastbound Regency Square Boulevard North will close at 7 p.m. and reopen by 7 a.m. the following mornings. Depending on destination, Tredinick Parkway, Regency Square Boulevard North, Arlington Expressway and Atlantic Boulevard traffic will detour via the southbound Southside Connector Service Road, Regency Square Boulevard North and Monument Road. (Detour and closure shown in Map 2 below.)
