

Southside Connector Southbound from Tredinick Parkway to Atlantic Boulevard/Arlington Expressway Closed Tonight

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Southside Connector southbound lanes from north of Tredinick Parkway to the Arlington Expressway and the ramp from eastbound Regency Square Boulevard North will close at 7 p.m. tonight, January 13 and reopen by 7 a.m. Friday, January 14. The closure, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting, is for work related to the Southside Connector resurfacing and improvement project.

Depending on destination, traffic will detour via the southbound Southside Connector Service Road to Tredinick Parkway, Regency Square Boulevard North, Monument Road, Arlington Expressway and Atlantic Boulevard.
