Sunday Night Detour Planned for Southbound I-295 East Beltway Near Butler Boulevard

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Southbound I-295 East Beltway drivers will see a detour overnight Sunday, January 10 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Drivers will be detoured at Town Center Parkway to Gate Parkway and J. Turner Butler Boulevard (State Road 202) to continue to their destinations (see map below).

The detour is necessary for crews to mill and resurface portions of the roadway and to shift traffic into its final configuration.

The express lanes project extends from State Road 9B to just north of J. Turner Butler Boulevard and consists of three new 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, construction of noise walls along I-295 in various locations, construction of drainage ponds and the installation of electronic tolling systems at various locations. Once complete, drivers will be offered a choice to use the two express lanes in each direction for a fee or remain on the non-tolled portion of I-295.


The \$179 million project was awarded to the Archer-Western Contractors design-build team and is expected to be completed in late 2021, weather and schedule permitting.
