Temporary Closures and Detours Continue in the Edgewood Avenue South Corridor April 27 to May 3

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Detours will continue at the intersection of Edgewood Avenue South and Roosevelt Boulevard (U.S. 17) for roundabout construction for approximately three weeks, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Current detours will be maintained from Monday at 7 a.m. through Friday at 5 p.m.; the detours will be lifted weekends from Friday at 5p.m. to Sunday at 8 p.m.

Additionally, the westbound Roosevelt Boulevard off-ramp to Edgewood Avenue will be closed continuously from 6 a.m. Monday, April 29 until 5 p.m. Friday, May 3. This closure will be in place for bridge cleaning and painting.

During construction, Edgewood Avenue South between Mayflower Street and the railroad tracks is closed to truck traffic. Deliveries in the area should seek alternate routes.
