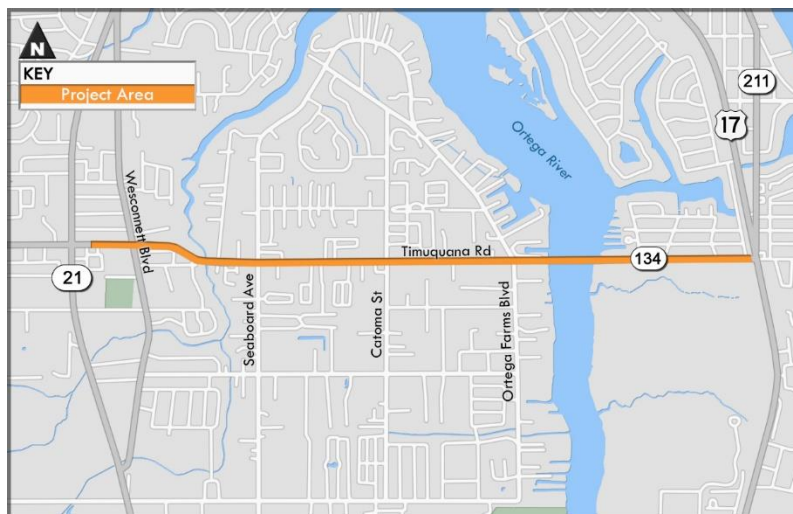
Timuquana Road Resurfacing to Begin Next Week

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is scheduled to begin a resurfacing project on 2.6 miles of Timuquana Road (State Road 134) from Wesconnett Boulevard to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) next week, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

This project includes removing and replacing the top layers of asphalt, which is expected to extend the lifespan of the road up to 20 years, the addition of 7-foot buffered bicycle lanes, drainage improvements, new highway signage and signal upgrades throughout the project limits.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. Drivers can expect single-lane closures during off-peak hours seven days a week. One lane in each direction will remain open at all times.

FDOT selected Duval Asphalt Products to complete this \$9.7 million project by fall 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
