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Traffic Signal Upgrades Along University Boulevard Begin Today

Jacksonville, Fla. – Construction for traffic signal upgrades along University Boulevard from Graywood Road to Bartram Road is underway.

The signals improvement project includes new span wire signals at University Boulevard and Graywood Road, St. Augustine Road, Brightway Center, Powers Avenue, Phillips Highway (U.S. 1), Richard Street, Spring Park Road, Barnes Road, Mt. Carmel Terrace, Beney Road, Kennerly Road, Booth Road and Bartram Road. Other items of construction include pedestrian signal upgrades, highway striping, crosswalk striping, highway signage, enhanced street lighting, concrete sidewalk and driveway replacements.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. Drivers can expect periodic single lane closures during off-peak driving hours. Lane closures may occur from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. seven days a week.

Traffic Control Devices Inc. is expected to complete this \$4 million improvement project in spring 2021, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The Florida Department of Transportation urges motorists to always follow the speed limit and stay within the limits of orange cones and barrels while traveling through construction zones.
