### Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A. The Florida Department of Transportation has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A improvement projects. Below are several lane closures planned for November 6 through November 13, weather permitting. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

#### Notable

- The eastbound right or left lane of State Road 200 from Harper Chapel Road to Still Quarters Road is expected to be closed Sunday, November 8 through Thursday, November 12 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. This is an alternating closure with only one lane closed at a time.
- The eastside and westbound right or left lane of State Road 200 from Dove Road to Still Quarters Road is expected to be closed Monday, November 9 and Tuesday, November 10 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. This is an alternating closure with only one lane closed at a time.
