Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

Yulee, Fla. – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A. For a complete list of scheduled lane closures in northeast Florida, interested parties may visit www.NFLRoads.com/TrafficReport.

Drivers can also set up real-time traffic alerts from FL511, a free service offered by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Motorists can visit www.FL511.com or download the FL511 app for this up-to-date information.

The Florida Department of Transportation has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A improvement projects. Below are several lane closures planned for July 10 through July 17, weather permitting. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

<u>Notable:</u> Monday, July 13 crews will be performing routine maintenance on both eastbound and westbound lanes of the Shave Bridge on State Road 200 in Nassau County. Lane closures may be implemented in order to complete the work. Drivers are encouraged are to plan ahead. This work is unrelated to the road improvement projects.

Daytime lane closures:

Interstate 95: None at this time.

State Road 200: None at this time.

Nighttime lane closures:

Interstate 95: None at this time.

State Road 200:

- The eastbound left lane of State Road 200 from Duval Road to Blackrock Road is expected to be considered Monday, July 13 and Tuesday, July 14 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Blackrock Road to David Hallman Parkway is expected to be closed Wednesday, July 15 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Duval Road to Blackrock Road is expected to be closed Thursday, July 16 and Friday, July 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
