Travel Advisory: State Road 200 Lane Closure Schedule

Yulee, Fla. – This advisory is to inform community leaders and interested parties about upcoming scheduled lane closures, traffic shifts and other construction activity on State Road 200/A1A. For a complete list of scheduled lane closures in northeast Florida, interested parties may visit www.NFLRoads.com/TrafficReport.

Drivers can also set up real-time traffic alerts from FL511, a free service offered by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). Motorists can visit www.FL511.com or download the FL511 app on a smart device for this up-to-date information.

The Florida Department of Transportation has permitted multiple lane closures as part of the State Road 200/A1A improvement projects. Below are several lane closures planned for September 11 through September 18, weather permitting. Certain activities may require unexpected lane closures for the safety of both drivers and construction workers.

<u>Notable:</u> Next week FDOT crews will temporarily close the I-95 northbound off-ramp and I-95 southbound on-ramp to State Road 200 overnight. Detour routes and dates of the closures are detailed below

Daytime lane closures:

Interstate 95:

• The northbound inside lane of I-95 from one mile south of the State Road 200 off ramp is expected to be closed Tuesday, September 8 through Thursday, September 10 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. This closure will not impact any ramps.

State Road 200:

• The eastbound right lane of State Road 200 from Chester Road to Flora Parke Crossing is expected to be closed Saturday, September 12 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Chester Road:

• The southbound left lane of Chester Road at State Road 200 is expected to be closed Saturday, September 12 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Interstate 95:

- The northbound inside lane of I-95 one mile south to the State Road 200 off-ramp is expected to be closed Monday, September 15 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. This will not impact any ramps.
- The southbound outside lane of I-95 one mile south from the State Road 200 on-ramp is expected to be closed Sunday, September 13 through Thursday, September 17 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. This will not impact any ramps.
- The I-95 southbound on-ramp from State Road 200 is expected to be closed Tuesday, September 15 through Thursday, September 17, from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers will be detoured to U.S. 17 southbound to Pecan Park Road to access I-95 southbound.
- The southbound inside lane of I-95 one mile south from the State Road 200 on-ramp is expected to be closed Sunday, September 13 through Thursday, September 17 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. This will not impact any ramps.
- The northbound outside lane of I-95 one mile south to the State Road 200 off-ramp is expected to be closed Wednesday, September 16 and Thursday, September 17 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. This will not impact any ramps.
- The I-95 northbound off-ramp to State Road 200 is expected to be closed Wednesday, September 16 and Thursday, September 17, from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Drivers will be detoured to Pecan Park Road to U.S. 17 northbound to access State Road 200. Drivers will also be able to continue north to the U.S. 17 exit to access I-95 southbound and the State Road 200 off-ramp.

State Road 200:

- The intersection of Stat Road 200 at Arrigo Boulevard is expected to be closed from Monday, September 14 through Wednesday, September 16 and Friday, September 18 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Harry Green Road to County Road 107/ O'Neil Scott Road is expected to be closed Monday, September 14 through Thursday, September 17 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- The westbound left lane of State Road 200 from Peeples Road to Felmor Road is expected to be closed Friday, September 11 and Friday, September 18 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
