

UPDATE: County Road 15A to Close Overnight Feb. 11-12

CLAY COUNTY, Fla. – The closure of County Road 15A originally scheduled for Feb. 10 and 11 is now expected to occur Feb. 11 and 12. A segment of County Road 15A is scheduled to close both nights from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. bridge beam-setting work, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During the closure, motorists traveling will be detoured approximately three miles via U.S. 17 and Green Cove Avenue as shown in the map below.
