Utility work planned Sunday on I-95 at Pecan Park Road for widening project

Jacksonville – In conjunction with the Florida Department of Transportation's roadwaywidening project on Pecan Park Road from I-95 to east of Lexington Park Boulevard, the Jacksonville Electric Authority (JEA) will be implementing a traffic pacing operation Sunday, April 8 starting at 7 a.m. on I-95 south and north at Pecan Park Road to safely complete electrical work.

Traffic pacing operations (rolling road block) will be coordinated by law enforcement officers and JEA personnel. Although preparations to perform the utility work will begin at 7 a.m., the utility work is scheduled to be completed by 8 a.m., pending weather delays or other unforeseen circumstances.

Petticoat-Schmitt Civil Contractors Inc. began the \$17.4 million widening project July 10, 2017 and are expected to complete the reconstruction work in late 2018, schedule permitting.
