## Westbound State Road 100 Traffic Shifts to New Overpass July 12

**STARKE, Fla.** – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's Starke Railroad Overpass Interchange Improvements project, traffic on westbound State Road 100 is expected to shift to the new overpass Wednesday, July 12, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Operations for this shift are expected to take place between 10 a.m. and 12 p.m. Westbound SR 100 will remain open during operations, but drivers should expect temporary delays. Traffic will be controlled with flaggers and the assistance of traffic control officers.

The backup date for the traffic shift will be Thursday, July 13.

FDOT hired J.B. Coxwell Contracting to complete this \$23.6 million project in late 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
