Westbound JTB traffic shift planned Thursday morning

Jacksonville – As part of the I-95/J. Turner Butler (JTB) Boulevard interchange improvement project, westbound JTB approaching the I-95 interchange will be placed in its final configuration Thursday, September 21, weather and schedule permitting.

Preparations to place the roadway in its final configuration will begin Wednesday, September 20 at 8 p.m. During this time, motorists should expect lane closures until 6 a.m.

Once traffic is shifted, motorists traveling westbound JTB intending to travel I-95 northbound will exit earlier and cross over the smaller flyover bridge. This new traffic pattern will eliminate the existing weave condition currently experienced while traveling from JTB westbound and Belfort Road.
