



Zoo Parkway Eastbound Ramp to Main Street Closed October 11 through October 18

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Zoo Parkway (State Road 105) eastbound ramp to Main Street (U.S. 17) will be closed Monday, October 11 at 7:30 a.m. through Friday, October 18 at 7 p.m. weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The five-day closure is needed for widening and guardrail work related to the Zoo Parkway resurfacing and improvement project. Main Street traffic from eastbound Zoo Parkway will detour via Heckscher Drive.



Digital message boards and signs will be in place to direct drivers through the respective detours.
