Edgewood Avenue Railroad Crossing Temporarily Closed for Repairs

Detours are expected to remain in place through November 25.


Jacksonville – The Edgewood Avenue South railroad crossing near U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) was temporarily closed Monday, November 18 at 8 a.m. The closure is expected to remain in place until Monday, November 25 while CSX completes crossing repairs.

During the closure, traffic will be detoured via U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) Edgewood Avenue, Post Street, Hamilton Street and Plymouth Street as shown in the map below.
