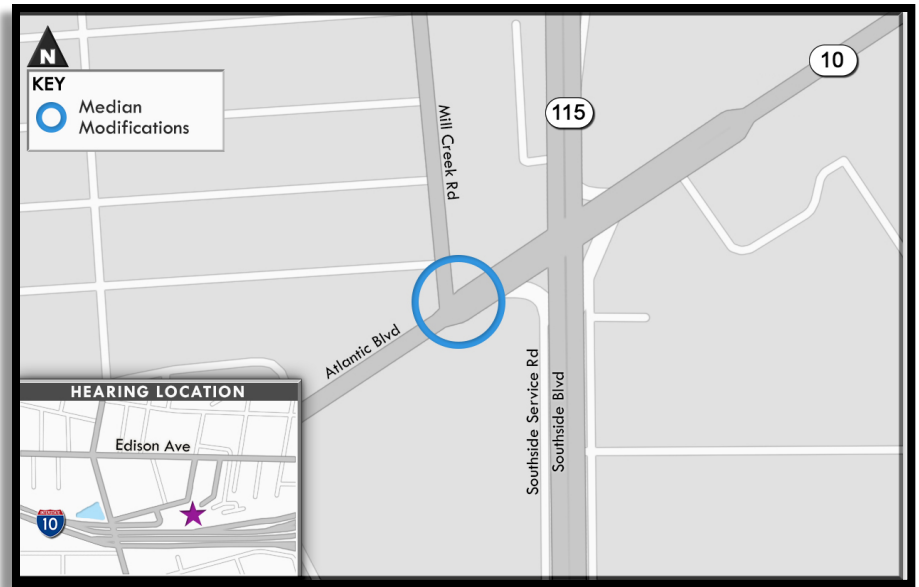

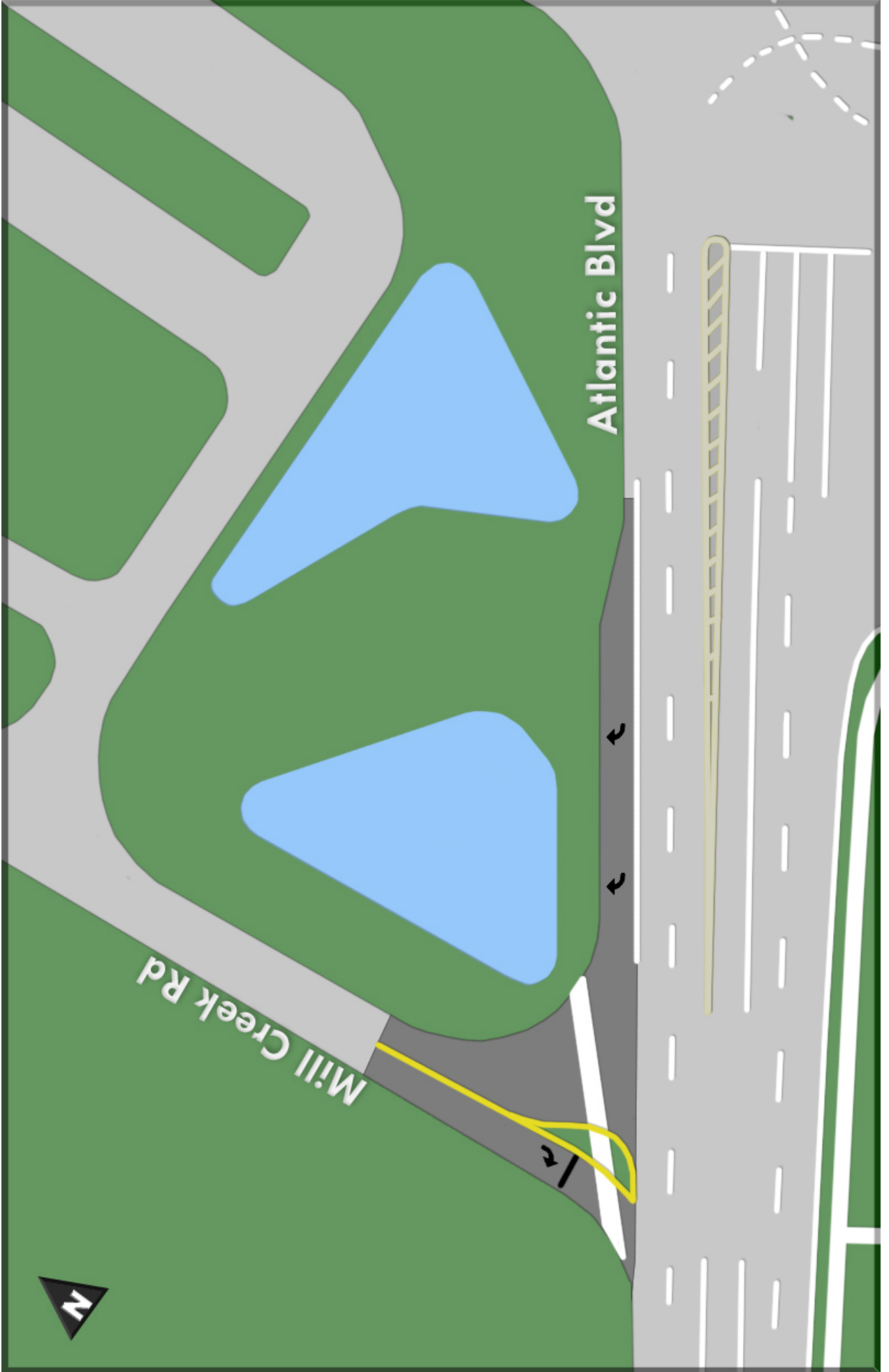


The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is hosting a public hearing to discuss a permit-related median modification at the Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10) and Mill Creek Road intersection to allow for the construction of a gas station at the corner of Southside Boulevard (State Road 115) and Atlantic Boulevard. To maintain a safe and efficient traffic flow on Atlantic Boulevard, FDOT proposes the developer install a raised concrete median at the intersection to prevent drivers from turning left (east) on Atlantic Boulevard and adding a dedicated right turn lane on Atlantic Boulevard to northbound Mill Creek Road. If approved, construction of the modifications will occur in summer 2021. (Conceptual rendering is on the back of this page.)

To provide citizens with an opportunity to share input on the proposed changes, FDOT will host a hybrid public hearing **Thursday, April 29, 2021**, online at nfroads.com/VPH or by phone at **(562) 247-8321**, access code **469-874-617**. Citizens who are unable to participate virtually or by phone may attend the hearing in person at the FDOT Urban Office Training Center, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. An informal open house will be held from 4 to 6 p.m., during which attendees may ask questions and discuss the project with members of the project team. A formal public comment period will begin at 6 p.m.

Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons who wish to submit written statements or other exhibits may do so prior to or during the hearing in the comments section at nfroads.com/VPH. Citizens may also submit questions, statements and other exhibits by sending them to Julian McKinley P.E., Maintenance Program Engineer, via email at julian.mckinley@dot.state.fl.us or mail at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before May 10, 2021 will become part of the public hearing record. Project-related documents are currently available for review at nfroads.com/VPH.PH.
