



Proposed Modifications

Fall 2023:

Install temporary delineators where future concrete separator may go. Delineators may look something like this.





Proposed Modifications

Fall 2024 – Spring 2025:

- Construct a traffic separator along the eastbound 39th Avenue left turn lane to 13th Street
- Construct a traffic separator along the westbound 39th Avenue left turn lane to 13th Street
- Extend the existing eastbound and westbound left turn lanes from 39th Avenue to 13th Street



Proposed Modification: Traffic Separator




Open your control panel window by clicking on the orange arrow icon.






View project related materials by clicking the dropdown arrow on the handouts bar and selecting an item.






Raise your hand to speak by clicking on the hand icon. A moderator will unmute your mic and call on you to speak.
