



Need for the Project

- Accommodate future traffic demand in the project area
- Bring the interchange up to current design standards

105,400 Vehicles per Day




140,000 Vehicles per Day

Proposed Improvements

- Replace the existing 295 Eastbound to 95 Northbound left-hand exit with a right-hand flyover
- Replace the existing 295 Westbound to 95 Southbound left-hand exit with a right-hand flyover
- Provide additional capacity at the 295 Westbound to 95 Northbound merge
- Upgrade signalized intersections at 295 and US-17 and 95 at Airport Road

Proposed Improvements – Noise Walls

- A noise barrier wall is proposed adjacent to the Biscayne Lake Estates and Cedar North neighborhoods.

- \$149 M (approx.)
