

WELCOME The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) would like to welcome you to the public workshop for the proposed improvements along I-10 from I-295 to I-95.

PROJECT PURPOSE FDOT is conducting a Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study to evaluate the addition of general purpose lane capacity improvements along I-10 from I-295 east to I-95, approximately 5 miles in Duval County. I-10 is a limited access facility that provides east-west access to and from the City of Jacksonville. This portion of I-10 connects downtown Jacksonville with the western urbanized area of Jacksonville and Duval County.

PROJECT NEED This segment of I-10 experiences peak period congestion due to demand that exceeds capacity. With expectations of continued traffic congestion, this PD&E Study will evaluate the addition of general purpose lanes to provide capacity improvements and relief to congestion.




PROJECT LOCATION MAP
