Introduction: The Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Gainesville are conducting a Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study to extend SW 62nd Boulevard from SW 20th Avenue to Clark Butler Boulevard.

Project Purpose: The purpose of the project is to reduce traffic congestion on nearby roadways by linking SW 43rd Street/Clark Butler Boulevard to SW 52nd Street. The project would provide a direct connection between commercial developments such as Butler Plaza to residential communities along SW 62nd Boulevard and SW 20th Street thus reducing traffic congestion on nearby roadways. The study area is currently served by seven transit routes and the project would allow for additional transit routes between commercial and residential developments further reducing congestion on nearby roadways.

Proposed Project: The proposed project would construct a new two-lane roadway from SW 43rd Street/Clark Butler Boulevard to the southern terminus of SW 52nd Street, a distance of 0.81 miles. The proposed project would consist of two 11-foot travel lanes, a 7-foot bicycles lane in each direction and a 10-foot multi-use path on the east side. The proposed project would also include a new bridge over Hogtown Creek and 2 new stormwater ponds. Additional right-of-way will be required and the project will impact 9 parcels and include 2 residential relocations. The project costs are listed below:
