
While comments about the project are accepted at any time, **please note that comments must be received by February 5, 2024**, to be included in the official meeting record.

**FDOT PROCESS**

The Florida Department of Transportation's process for delivering a project through construction consists of five phases, Planning, Project Development and Environment, Design, Right of Way Acquisition, and Construction. Currently, the Seawall Replacement along A1A from the Bridge of Lions to Charlotte Street is in the Project Development or the PD&E Phase.
