Heckscher Drive at I-295 Intersection Improvements Project Begins Late April

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Construction on an intersection improvements project on Heckscher Drive (State Road 105) at I-295 (State Road 9A) is scheduled to begin this month.

J.B. Coxwell Contracting, Inc. was selected to complete the \$4.4 million project. The project will add a westbound dedicated turn lane to I-295 North beginning at New Berlin Road and signal upgrades on the I-295 North on-ramp to enhance traffic flow. In addition, project improvements include base work, shoulder treatment, drainage upgrades, curb and gutter, highway signing, sidewalks/bicycle path and other incidental construction. Completion is estimated in late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During construction, the public is encouraged to follow detour signs and use caution in the area. Lane closures will only be permitted from 12 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. to 12 a.m.
