Overnight Detours of I-10 and U.S. 301 Interchange Planned from May 5 to May 9

BALDWIN, Fla. – As part of the I-10 and U.S. 301 interchange improvement project, multiple ramps at the I-10 and U.S. 301 interchange are scheduled to close nightly Sunday, May 5 through Thursday, May 9 for resurfacing work. Ramps will close from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During the closures, the following detours will be in place:

<u>Eastbound I-10 Ramp to U.S. 301 Closed</u>: Drivers will continue east and use the First Coast Expressway (State Road 23) interchange to access I-10 West to U.S. 301.

Westbound I-10 Ramp to U.S. 301 Closed: Drivers will continue west to State Road 228 (exit 336) and take I-10 East to access U.S. 301.

Northbound U.S. 301 Ramp to I-10 West Closed: Drivers will take westbound U.S. 90 to southbound State Road 228 to access I-10.

<u>Southbound U.S. 301 Ramp to I-10 West Closed:</u> Southbound U.S. 301 traffic will take I-10 East to the First Coast Expressway (State Road 23) interchange to access I-10 West.

Southbound U.S. 301 Ramp to I-10 East Closed:

Drivers on U.S. 301 north of U.S. 90 and traffic on U.S. 90 will travel east on U.S. 90, then south on the First Coast Expressway to access I-10 East. Drivers on U.S. 301 south of U.S. 90 will take Normandy Boulevard (State Road 228) east, New World Avenue north and First Coast Expressway north to access I-10 East.

Northbound U.S. 301 Ramp to I-10 East Closed:

Drivers will continue north on U.S. 301 and take U.S. 90 east to southbound First Coast Expressway to access I-10 East.
