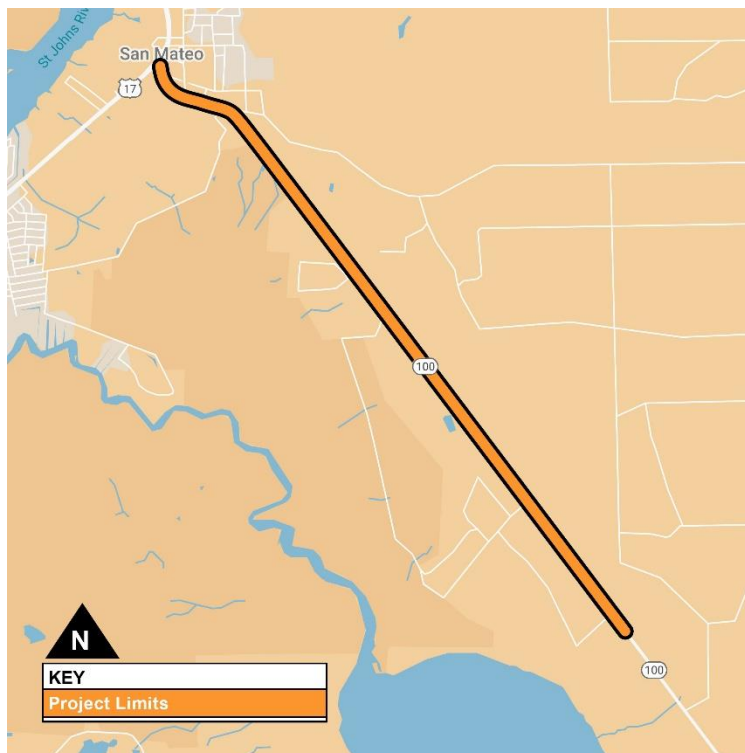

State Road 100 from U.S. 17 to the Flagler County Line Resurfacing Project Begins This Month

PUTNAM COUNTY, Fla. – Construction on a resurfacing project of State Road 100 from U.S. 17 to the Flagler County Line is scheduled to begin this month.

P & S Paving, Inc. was selected to complete the \$3.3 million rehabilitation project. Improvements under this contract consist of milling and resurfacing, signage upgrades, new pavement markings and other incidental construction. Completion is estimated in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During construction, the public is encouraged to use caution in the area while traveling through work zones.
