

PROPOSED DIRECTIONAL MEDIAN ON STATE ROAD 228






To maintain safety and manage access to the proposed site, FDOT would require the developer to construct a directional median on Normandy Boulevard, east of Manning Cemetery Road. The developer would fund this construction at no cost to taxpayers.

This rendering illustrates vehicle movements within the proposed directional median.

To enhance safety and traffic flow, delineators will be installed to prevent westbound left-in movements from obstructing the through lane and adjacent left-turn lane.

These delineators will also restrict direct left-out movements from the development.

However, all restricted movements will continue to be accommodated via the developer's internal roadway network.




